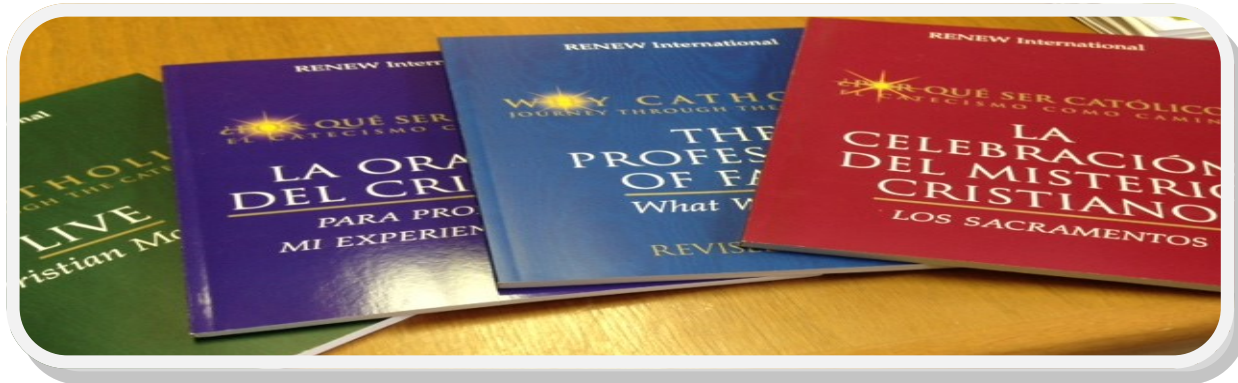


Renew International: Why Catholic? - We Have Been Blessed!
